Don Lake is Professor Emeritus, Parkland College in Champaign, Illinois where he taught painting and drawing for 38 years, serving as department chair for 25 of those years. He also teaches at Eastern Illinois University in the graduate art ed program, and taught watercolor workshop courses at Arrowmont School of Art and Design for 25 years among other places.



He has been a practicing studio painter since the early 1970s and continues his studio work today.



Best known for his realist watercolor industrial images, Don Lake also paints the landscape of the Midwest and southwest, and imagery from his travels. He is widely published and has shown in juried shows and in galleries in Chicago and St Louis. He is currently represented by Cinema Gallery in Urbana, Illinois.

I also was not trying to find different styles of work to award. That just happened to show up once the best pieces in the entries were all lined up.


It was very nice to have more than one piece per person to give some sense of consistency and ability.












