Join us on **Wednesday, March 9th at 10:00 a.m.** program by Giovanna Simeoni from Munich, Germany. Giovanna composes art in many media and you can see examples of her work on her website: studio-arte.it. Click English on the top to translate it from Italian.

From Giovanna:

I will make a demo around the topic "atmospheric perspective", the great invention of Leonardo da Vinci. How to show space and distance without the geometrical lines. Watercolours are the best suited and I have a suitable landscape for it.

Atmospheric perspective and watercolours allow us to explore the difference between solid, liquid and gaseous elements in space and let us feel the distances, without need of lines.

The topic summarizes my different careers and viewpoints too, and in doing so I can discuss some technical choices of mines with respect to the Italian Renaissance and Venetian painting school, famous for atmospheres and colours (I come from the region of Venetian masters like Paolo Veronese, Tintoretto, Giorgione, Canaletto, Tiepolo etc.).
